

### What to Do After a Car Accident: A Quick Guide



#### 1. Seek Medical Attention

- Your health is the priority. Call 911 for emergencies or visit a doctor promptly.
- Some injuries may not be immediately apparent.



#### 2. Gather Information

- Exchange contact and insurance details with all involved parties.
- Obtain contact information from witnesses.
- Take photos of the accident scene, vehicle damage, and any visible injuries.
- Save any Dash Cam or Video footage you may have in a safe place. Ask nearby facilities if they may have any footage from their properties cameras.



#### 3. Report the Accident

- Notify your insurance company about the accident, providing accurate details.
- In some cases, you may need to file a police report, especially if there are injuries or significant property damage.



#### 4. Document Everything

- Keep records of all medical treatments, expenses, and any lost wages due to the accident.
- Maintain a file of all communication related to the accident, including with insurance companies and medical providers.
